Virtual Public Meeting with an In-Person Option
State Loop (SL) 335, Segment C-2
From FM 1719 (Western Street) to Echo Street and US 87 from
north of Hastings Avenue to south of Cherry Avenue
CSJs: 2635-04-040 and 2635-01-040
Potter County, Texas

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) Amarillo District and the Amarillo Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) is proposing to improve State Loop (SL) 335 from FM 1719 (Western Street) to Echo Street and US 87 from north of Hastings Avenue to south of Cherry Avenue in Potter County, Texas. This notice advises the public that TxDOT will be conducting a virtual public meeting with an in-person option on the proposed project. The virtual public meeting will be available beginning at 2 p.m. on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022, and will be posted at <https://www.txdot.gov/projects/hearings-meetings.html>. The in-person option will be held on Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022 at Diversity Church, 5631 Pavillard Drive, Amarillo, Texas 79108. Two identical public open house meetings will take place from 2 - 4 p.m. and from 6 - 8 p.m. and will follow an "open house" format. The purpose of the public meeting is to present the proposed project and receive public comment. A TxDOT staff member will deliver a presentation at both live public open house meetings. A live question and answer period will not be conducted; however, questions will be answered by staff during the open house meeting. A prerecorded copy of the same presentation will be available in the virtual public meeting.

The proposed project would consist of improving an existing four-lane roadway along SL 335 to a four-lane divided roadway with ramps, four direct connectors planned as an ultimate connection to/from US 87 north of SL 335, one-way frontage roads, and grade separations over intersecting cross streets. The proposed project would also provide bicycle and pedestrian accommodations via an 11-foot shared-use path adjacent to each frontage road.

The proposed project along US 87 north of SL 335 would consist of improving the existing four-lane divided roadway to allow for connections from the four direct connectors planned as an ultimate connection to/from SL 335 and provide bicycle and pedestrian accommodations via an 11-foot shared-use path adjacent to each frontage road.

The proposed project along US 87 south of SL 335 would consist of improving the existing four-lane divided roadway with bicycle and pedestrian accommodations, including a striped 5-foot bicycle lane with 2-foot delineated separation along the outer edge of each frontage road and 6-foot sidewalks adjacent to each frontage road.

Although additional right of way will be required, no residential or commercial displacement will occur in the near future as this project is not currently funded and is not listed in TxDOT's 4-year Statewide Transportation Improvement Program. Information concerning services and benefits available to affected property owners and information about the tentative schedule for right-of-way acquisition and construction can be obtained from the TxDOT district office at the address listed below.

The public meeting will be conducted in English. If you need an interpreter or document translator because English is not your primary language or you have difficulty communicating effectively in English, one will be provided to you. If you have a disability and need assistance, special arrangements can be made to accommodate most needs. If you need interpretation or translation services or you are a person with a



disability who requires an accommodation to attend and participate in the public meeting, please contact Jacy Butler, Amarillo District, at (806) 356-3200 no later than 4 p.m. CT, Thursday, Nov. 10, 2022. Please be aware that advance notice is required as some services and accommodations may require time for the Texas Department of Transportation to arrange.

Written comments from the public regarding the proposed project are requested and may be presented at the in-person meeting. Written comments may also be submitted by mail to the TxDOT Amarillo District Office, 5715 Canyon Drive, Amarillo, Texas 79110. Written comments may also be submitted by email to AMA_Project_Input@txdot.gov. All comments must be received or postmarked by Wednesday, Dec. 7, 2022. Responses to comments received will be on file and available for inspection at the Amarillo District Office as well as on www.txdot.gov once they have been prepared.
