US 82 Improvement Projects (Includes 3 Sections) – Bowie County

Proposed Project Objective

This project seeks to improve mobility and safety along this section of the US 82 corridor.

Proposed Project Improvements

- 1) US 82 De Kalb Section includes widening, reconstruction, and realignment. The proposed roadway section will consist of one 12-foot travel lane in each direction, one 14-foot shared use lane in each direction to accommodate bicycles, a continuous center left turn lane, and sidewalks for pedestrians. A drainage design featuring a new storm drain system with inlets will also be installed.
- 2 US 82 Middle Section includes widening only. The proposed roadway section will consist of two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, a shoulder in each direction, and a continuous center left turn lane. The drainage in this section will be accommodated by open ditches.
- 3 US 82 at I-30 Section includes widening, reconstruction, and realignment. The proposed roadway section will consist of two 12-foot travel lanes in each direction, a shoulder in each direction, and a continuous center left turn lane. The drainage in this section will be accommodated by open ditches.
